16th to 20th Nov 2024

1 TOKYO TO TOTTORI

Meet Ken at the hotel to depart Haneda Airport for Tottori City. Upon arrival, we will depart for a short drive to Watanabe Museum of Art. Lunch at local restaurant, Ray Garden Cafe. After lunch, we will stop by at the spectacular Tottori Sand Dunes, followed by a visit to the Sand Museum.

2 FULL DAY TOTTORI

After breakfast, we will depart for Aoya Washi Kobou (Japanese paper workshop) After lunch at local restaurant, we will depart for Tottori Nijisseiki Pear Museum. Learn and experience the history and cultivation of pears and taste 3 varieties of fresh pear any time of the year.

We then depart for Kurayoshi City- and its historic White Wall District which faithfully retains the ambience of its origins in the Edo and Meiji periods. Try on Japanese kimono, before checking in to an authentic Japanese Ryokan (Inn). Enjoy Kaiseki Dinner and the hotel's natural spring baths.

3 TOTTORI - YONAGO CITY

Depart for the famous Tottori Prefectural Flower Park (Hanakairo) This 50-hectare flower park features outdoor gardens, as well as a greenhouses and enclosed walkways. After lunch, we will depart for Yonago City. Upon arrival, visit Matsue Castle, a National Treasure, and one of few remaining feudal Japanese castles in their original wooden form.

We then depart for Adachi Museum of Art, which is best known for having one of the greatest collections of modern to contemporary Japanese art, ceramics and a huge Japanese garden. Dinner at local Restaurant.

4 FULL DAY IN SHIMANE PREFECTURE

After breakfast at the hotel, we will first visit Shimane Prefecture Ancient History Museum, to learn about the background history of Izumo, which is called the "land of gods". Lunch at local restaurant, followed by a visit Izumo Taisha, one of the most ancient and prominent shrines in Japan.

We will then visit Inasa Beach, which is a spiritual spot with mythical connections, before returning to the hotel.
