

TOKYO Arrival

Arrive at either Narita Int'l Airport or Haneda Int'l Airport. The Park Hotel Tokyo is located on the 25th floor of the Shiodome Media Tower downtown, where you'll enjoy a stunning panorama of the city from your window.

TOKYO

Among many highlights of the day will be the Imperial Palace, Meiji Shrine, Omotesando shopping area, Ginza district, and Hama Rikyu L **Gardens**. 

We'll travel to Koriyama, gateway to Fukushima's mountain ranges to the east and west. Your guide, Ken Takenaga, will meet you. Your first stop by private bus is the famed **Tsuruga Castle**. After a local lunch, we'll continue on to **Ouchijuku**, a former post town in a beautiful mountain setting.

KORIYAMA -KITAKAMI - HANAMAKI

Today, we'll travel leisurely by car to our destination, stopping en-route at the famous Tenshochi Park in Kitakami. Registered as one of the 100 Best Sakura Viewing Sites in Japan. After that, you'll be ready to relax in a steaming hot springs bath at our onsen inn tonight. Accommodation: Osawa Onsen Sansuikaku (2 nights)





HANAMAKI - HIRAIZUMI - HANAMAKI

We depart hotel and head south to Hiraizumi and its top attraction: Chusonji Buddhist Temple. This Tendai-sect Buddhist temple commands a spectacular view of cherry blossoms in full bloom. Among the few remaining sites here is the fabulous Golden Pavilion, completely covered in gold leaf.

Accommodation: Osawa Onsen Sansuikaku





HANAMAKI- MORIOKA

After breakfast, we will depart for Morioka, with a stop at the Morioka Handy-Works Square. This amazing cultural craft "village" offers workshops as well as a wide range of stores selling popular gift items by master craftsmen.

Accommodation: Hotel Metropolitan New Wing (3 nights)





MORIOKA - KAKUNODATE

Today, you'll step back in time to the samurai era in fabled Kakunodate. The wide open streets lined by a lacy canopy of cherry blossoms frames a picture-perfect view into the past. There are museums, gift shops, gardens and architecture to explore here. Accommodation: Hotel Metropolitan New Wing





MORIOKA - AOMORI

After breakfast, we will depart for Aomori for a day trip. We will pick up our car and depart for the Sannai-Maruyama archaeological site and museum, containing the ruins of a very large JOMON period settlement. After lunch at the local restaurant, we will depart for the Hirosaki City. Accommodation Hotel Metropolitan New Wing
